- 3. Shift a challenging child to using his or her intensity in successful ways, even if the child has ADHD, oppositional defiant disorder, giftedness, or is challenging in some other way.
- 4. Reduce the need for medications.
- 5. Choose techniques for creating successes that are far more extensive and powerful than existing approaches.
- 6. Utilize techniques for avoiding the traps of accidentally "rewarding" negativity while still upholding perfect accountability.
