The Face of Bullying

Growing up, the picture that often came to mind, when someone would talk about the bully at school. was that big kid on the playground, strong arming kids for their lunch money. Flash forward to the 21st century and bullying takes on a whole new face. Physical intimidation, while still a part of the bullying picture, has moved aside for new forms of bullying including verbal, social isolation and cyber bulling. Where once it was boys intimidating other boys, it has now moved to girls bullying girls, bullying of children with special needs, and yes, even adults in the work place.

Here are the facts:

- Children with a disability have a two to three times higher risk of being bullied
- Physical bullying has become less common while social isolation and cyber bullying has become the norm
- One in three children experience some type of cyberbullying and 50% of children who have experienced that type of bullying do not tell their parents.
- 57% of bullying stops when a peer intervenes on behalf of the person being bullied.
- For some kids, bullying means the start of anxiety, depression, lower self-esteem and poor school attendance.
- Bystanders can develop anxiety from witnessing bullying.

Often times children do not have the verbal skills to explain what is happening. They may tell you through their behaviors such as wanting to stay home from school; unexplained tummy aches; changes in their mood and/or sleep; and becoming disinterested in school happenings.

So, what does a parent do when their child tells them that someone is "picking on them" at school?

- Document the information your child provides including date, time of day, and who was present.
- Give your child some time and space for your child to process how they are feeling. Offer support but don't be over dramatic about the incident or infuse your own emotions with what your child is feeling.
- Help them develop a plan to address the bullying (who to tell, walk away, etc.)
- Do not tell them to "toughen up" "hit back" or encourage other actions that may get your child in trouble.
- If you feel comfortable talking with the parent of the child who is doing the bullying, focus your conversation on helping the kids and not pointing fingers.
- Contact the school administration to report the bullying activity.

With LobbyGuard, all visitors to district facilities will be expected to scan a drivers' license or state ID card to gain access beyond the main office. Please be sure to bring your ID inside with you, if you need to enter the school.

LobbyGuard uses the information on the ID and compares it against national offender databases and local red flag databases in seconds. Visitors will then receive a custom visitor ID tag, printed on the spot.

Level Descriptions

Parent/Child (PC): 6 months to 3 years. Comfort and having fun in the water. One adult accompanies each child in the water.

Level 1: Starting Age of 3 years old. Water adjustment and moving through the water with instructor assistance.

Level 2: Front and back floating and moving through the water using floatation devices.

Level 3: Kicking and beginning swimming on front and back without assistance.

Level 4: Kicking and swimming freestyle and backstroke up to 10 yards.

Level 5: Continued skill progression and increased distance for freestyle and backstroke plus diving from pool side.

Level 6: Dolphin and breaststroke kicking and freestyle and backstroke flip turns and increased distance.

Level 7: Swimming butterfly and breaststroke and five pool widths of freestyle and backstroke.

Level 8: Swimming freestyle and backstroke with flip turns for 180 yards. Diving off the starting blocks.

Participants who pass Levels 6-8 are encouraged to register for Springboard Diving or Red Dragon Swim Team.

DOES SCOUTING BUILD CHARACTER?

Yes, Scouting programs build character and leadership abilities as well as help boys grow mentally, physically, socially, and spiritually. The skills they learn in Scouting help them overcome obstacles and challenges with character and courage throughout their lives.

Scouting was put to the test over the course of a three year study that concluded the end of 2015, when a research team from Tufts University worked with the Boy Scouts of America to measure the character attributes of both Scouts and non-Scouts—all with the goal of better understanding the character development of youth as it was happening. Over the course of the study the change in positive character attributes for Scouts vs. non-Scouts became evident. 2,000 + Scouts and non-Scouts aged 6-12 were measured in 6 key areas as indicated below in the Change in Character chart:
