

# 2019-20 Jump Start Preschool

Moorhead Area Public Schools • Community Education

## What is Jump Start?

Jump Start offers age appropriate activities, curriculum and assessment. All classes will also include circle time, snack, art and learning centers. This is a collaborative venture with Early Intervention Services. Children working on special areas of development will participate with typically developing peers. Jump Start Preschool is available to 3, 4 and 5-year-old children living in the Moorhead Area Public School District.



## When is Jump Start?

Children will attend either the morning or afternoon session of Jump Start.

**Jump Start Preschool** – Must be 4-years-old by September 1, 2019 and will be attending kindergarten in the fall of 2020.

- Four days a week, Monday through Thursday
- 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. or noon to 2:30 p.m.

**Jump Start for Threes** – Must be 3-years-old by September 1, 2019 and will be attending kindergarten in the fall of 2021.

- Two days a week, Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday
- 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. or noon to 2:30 p.m.

Jump Start will operate only on days when school is in session and will follow the regular school calendar.

**\*\* Transportation is not provided. Parents will be responsible for their child's transportation needs.**



## What will my child be doing during Jump Start?

Children will develop skills needed for success as they enter kindergarten.

- Language and Literacy
- Mathematical experiences
- Movement activities
- Social skills

Children will learn through

- Creative arts
- Discovery activities
- Hands-on experiences

Parent involvement and engagement is encouraged throughout the experience.

## Who will teach my child?

The Jump Start teacher is a licensed Early Childhood Teacher. Each classroom has a teacher's assistant and is supported by an Early Intervention Teacher.

## Where are the Jump Start classrooms located?

Jump Start classrooms are located at Probstfield Center for Education, 2410 14th Street South, door 3.

## How much does Jump Start cost? How will I be billed?

The cost is based on the parents' ability to pay using the federal income eligibility guidelines in the

table below. Determine your fee based on your household's size and annual income level.

Monthly payments are due by the first business day of each month. Monthly Jump Start payments should be made online through Eleyo, which is Community Education's online payment processing system. Parents may contact Moorhead Community Education to make other arrangements to pay for Jump



Start. Payment should not be sent to the Jump Start teacher.

Refunds will not be provided when a child is absent or when school is closed due to inclement weather. Moorhead Community Education reserves the right to discontinue a child's enrollment in the Jump Start program due to non-payment of fees. If a child is absent for 15 consecutive days, they will be removed from the class and placed on the wait-list.
