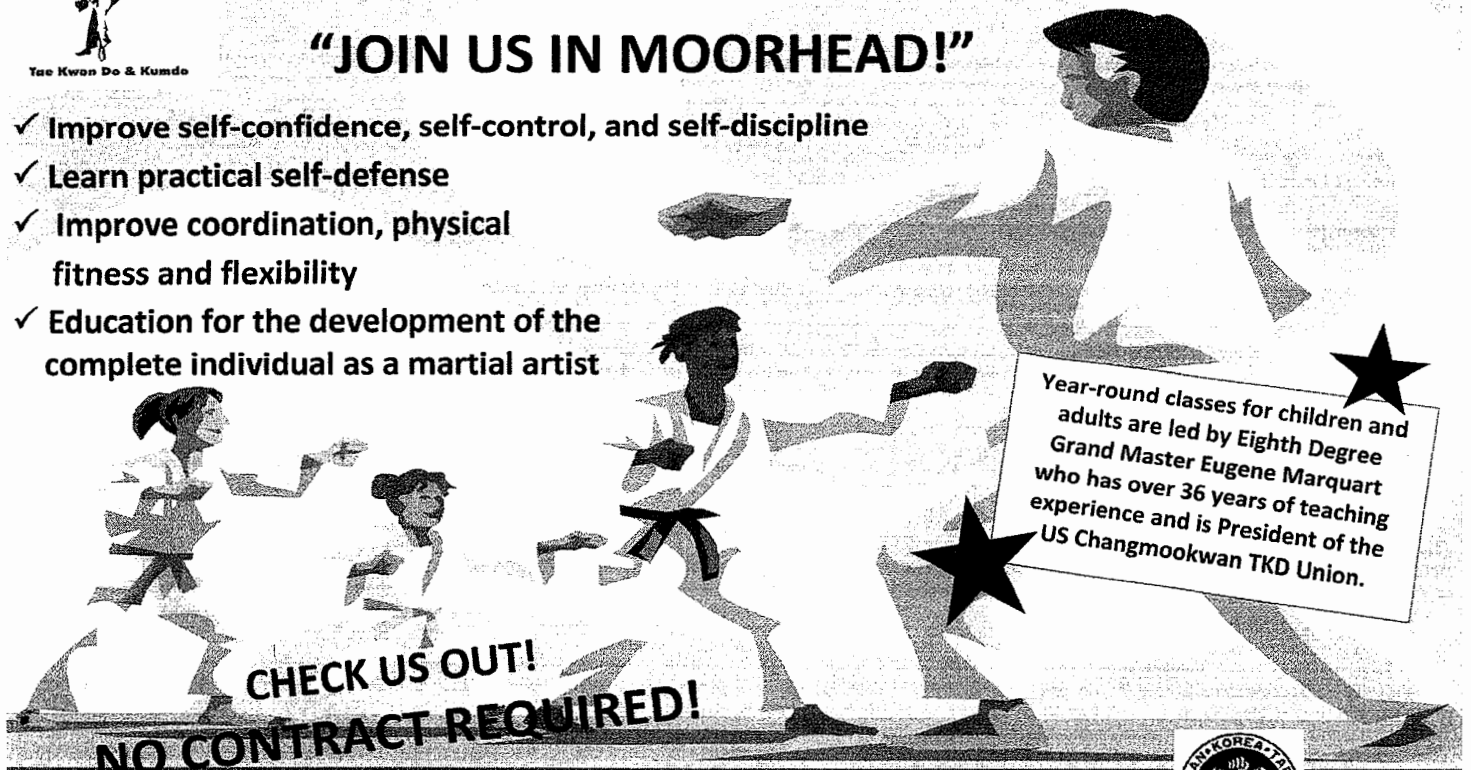

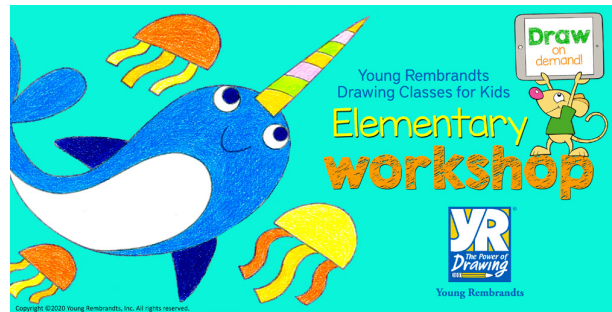
Anime Manga-On Demand June 8th-Sept 4th

Jump Start Preschool

Although Jump Start sections may be full, you can call and be added to our waiting list. We will contact families as space becomes available during the year.

2020-21 Jump Start

Jump Start is available to 3, 4 and 5-year-old children living in the Moorhead Public School District. Jump Start Preschool offers age-appropriate activities, curriculum and assessment. The preschool also will include circle time, snack, art and learning centers. This is a collaborative venture with Early Intervention Services. Children working on special areas of development will participate with typically developing peers.

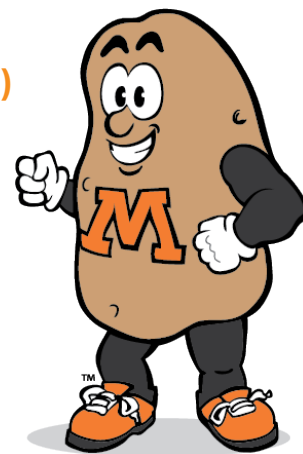

Summer Camps Safety Guidelines

Moorhead Community Education wants you to stay healthy and connected this summer! Your health and safety are important to us, so we have added health and safety modifications to our classes and activities based on the MDE, MDH and CDC guidelines.

Communication

- Social distancing guidelines, hygiene protocols and class procedures are available in the course description online when registering.
- An email will be sent several days before class starts reminding students of class date, time and location, along with social distancing guidelines, hygiene protocols and class procedure.
- You will be notified of what supplies/equipment to bring to class (if applicable). Students should use their own supplies/equipment brought or assigned to them and avoid sharing with others.
- Face masks are encouraged but not required; students must provide their own face mask.
- Stay home if you do not feel well.

Arrival to Class

- We ask that parents screen children and adults do self-screening before attending class. Please do not attend class if participant has the following:
 - new onset or worsening cough OR
 - shortness of breath OR
 - at least two of the following symptoms: fever (100.4° F or higher); chills; muscle pain; headache; sore throat; new loss of taste or smell.
- Stay home if you do not feel well.
- Use designated arrival door or field entrance; this information is provided during registration. Class arrival times may be staggered; you will be notified of any changes in times.
- Students may be screened onsite upon arrival.
- Wash or sanitize hands immediately upon entry to the building.
- Sit in an assigned seat or wait in a designated outdoor location for the start of class.
- Maintain social distancing.
- Bring your own labeled water bottle, there will not be access to a drinking fountain.

During Class

- Face masks are encouraged, but not required; please provide your own face mask if desired.
- Sit in an assigned seat or area throughout class and maintain social distancing.
- You will be notified of what supplies to bring to class (if applicable); students should use their own supplies/equipment brought or assigned to them and avoid sharing with others.
- Wash or sanitize hands as needed.
- Cover your cough with a tissue or use your elbow. Wash or sanitize hands after.
- Spectators will not be allowed.

Departure from Class

- Clean your area as directed by the instructor or coaches.
- Take all personal supplies and equipment with you.
- Exit building using designated departure door or field entrance.
- Wait in a designated area for pick up, maintaining social distancing from others also waiting.
- Community Education and custodial staff will clean and sanitize all facilities, materials, equipment, chairs and tables following each class.

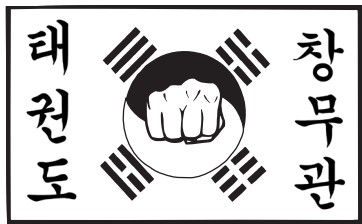
