In-Person Learning

0-9 cases: Everyone; 10-19 cases: Elementary

In-Person Learning Overview:

Students attend school physically five days per week. Additional safety precautions are in place to ensure students are learning in the safest environment possible.

What does In-Person Learning look like?

- Students are in school five days a week in face-to-face learning with teachers and interacting with peers and classmates.
- Additional safety precautions will be followed, including face coverings.
 Schools will create as much space between students as feasible, but will not be held strictly to 6 feet of social distancing.
- School day may be shortened to accommodate teacher prep times and safe busing schedules.
